If you're planning to take a trip down Interstate 70 any time soon, you might want to check out GOI70.com before you leave. This brand new informative website just launched by the I-70 Coalition has a lot of information you will need before you hit the road.

Information such as current weather, road conditions, travel times along the highway, text alerts about your trip, as well as information about carpooling, activities and dining. Even if you want to know the best travel times, find an extra rider to share expenses, get directions to a parking space, or a good deal on an overnight stay, go to GoI70.com and be informed.

Once you are on the road, you can check <http://goi70.com/mobile> for the latest highway news and current travel speeds or have text alerts sent directly to your cell phone to alert you on changing road conditions.

For those of you interested in other Colorado informative websites for drivers, the state of Colorado now allows you to link your driver's license information to up to two emergency contacts. Information does not appear on your license, but is accessible to emergency responders.
